Club Molisani & Mayfield Heights Team Up on Bocce Court Improvement!

Club Molisani and the City of Mayfield Heights have had a long and positive relationship built around the sport of bocce. Club Molisani operates the Marshall Superstore Cleveland International Challenge Cup of Bocce every August, which is hosted by the City of Mayfield Heights as part of its Unity Days Celebration. Five years ago, the City added three courts to the existing five courts that have been in the city park since the early 1980's. The new courts were added partly to handle the growth of the bocce tournament, but mostly to handle the overwhelming amount of bocce that is played at the park courts. Every night until 11:00pm, the courts are full of men and women who enjoy the game and each others company. Every evening, the bocce venue actually resembles a piazza, which is located in the center of every city and small town in Italy.

The three courts have not been playing as fast as they should be. So, members of Club Molisani and the City partnered once again to create a Court Improvement Project. The City purchased Har Tru, a tennis court covering that also works very well as bocce court covering because it hardens well and can be leveled easily. Club Molisani purchased crushed limestone and new backboards and hardware to finish off the three courts. A collection was also taken by the Monday Night Ladies League and the Wednesday Night Mens League to help defray some of the costs. All were happy to contribute to this important project.

Last weekend, a total of 35 men completed a total renovation of the three courts as well as installing new backboards to all eight courts. The five existing courts also saw improvements made for leveling and speed. In fact, a father and his two young sons were the first to jump on court #1 to see how it played. Two years ago, the City constructed a huge pavilion over the five existing courts so bocce players can enjoy the game rain or shine.

Mayor Greg Costabile and City Council should be applauded for sparking the restoration of the city's bocce courts by purchasing the Har Tru material. Club Molisani members took over the project from there. Their expertise in building bocce courts is unsurpassed, whether outdoor limestone or indoor synthetic rubber. Service Director, Andy Fornaro and his right-hand man for the project, Roman Koscho, should be given much of the credit for the final outcome also.

Bocce leagues are present on the city's courts every night. From now on, the outside courts will receive the same respect given the inside courts. Thanks to all volunteers who contributed to the success of the Court Improvement Project. It was hard work, but absolutely worth it.


