On November 16th Club Molisani held its first ever wine pairing event with great success. Ticket sales exceeded our initially set limit by 50%. The event, Off the Beaten Path, featured several Italian wines from established and rising wine regions of Italy.

Guests started off in Veneto which offered a sparkling rosé called Bisol Jeio Rosé and was paired with the antipasto table. They then moved onto Piedmont where a Barbara was served with Mushroom Crostini. In Toscano, Chianti was served with Spinich and White Bean and then while in Abruzzo guests were served Montepulciano with Polenta Ragu. While in Puglia, Negroamaro was the wine of the region paired with Orecchiette Broccolineta. The last 2 stops were Campania and Sicily where Falanghina was served with Sausage Vesuvius and Nero d'Avola was served with Eggplant Rotolare, respectively.

The event also included a homemade wine tasting event that included 20 some bottles of wine created by our guests. Brought in to judge the wines were 2 judges from the Northern Ohio Wine Guild and one sommelier, which spent several hours critiquing and grading the wines. Winners included 1st place Mike Inghram, 2nd place Butch Manfroni, 3rd place Bob Monitello, and 4th place Pat Perrino. Winners received medals and all participates received the judges scoring cards to see how their wines were judged.

We would like to thank Mario Ferritto and Adelio DiFranco for putting the event together and we would like to thank all the

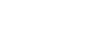


